Christmas Stamps

Our 2025 Bailiwick Christmas stamps are now available to buy, celebrating the much-loved carol The Twelve Days of Christmas. The Alderney stamps illustrate verses one to six, from the partridge in a pear tree to six geese a-laying, while the Guernsey stamps continue with verses seven to twelve, featuring swans, dancers, milkmaids and drummers. Each design is set against festive greenery and wintry scenes, capturing the carol's charm. Together, the series offers a complete, joyful interpretation of this timeless song. The reduced-rate stamps (64p) are available to use on locally posted Christmas cards up to 100g between 24th November and 22nd December.

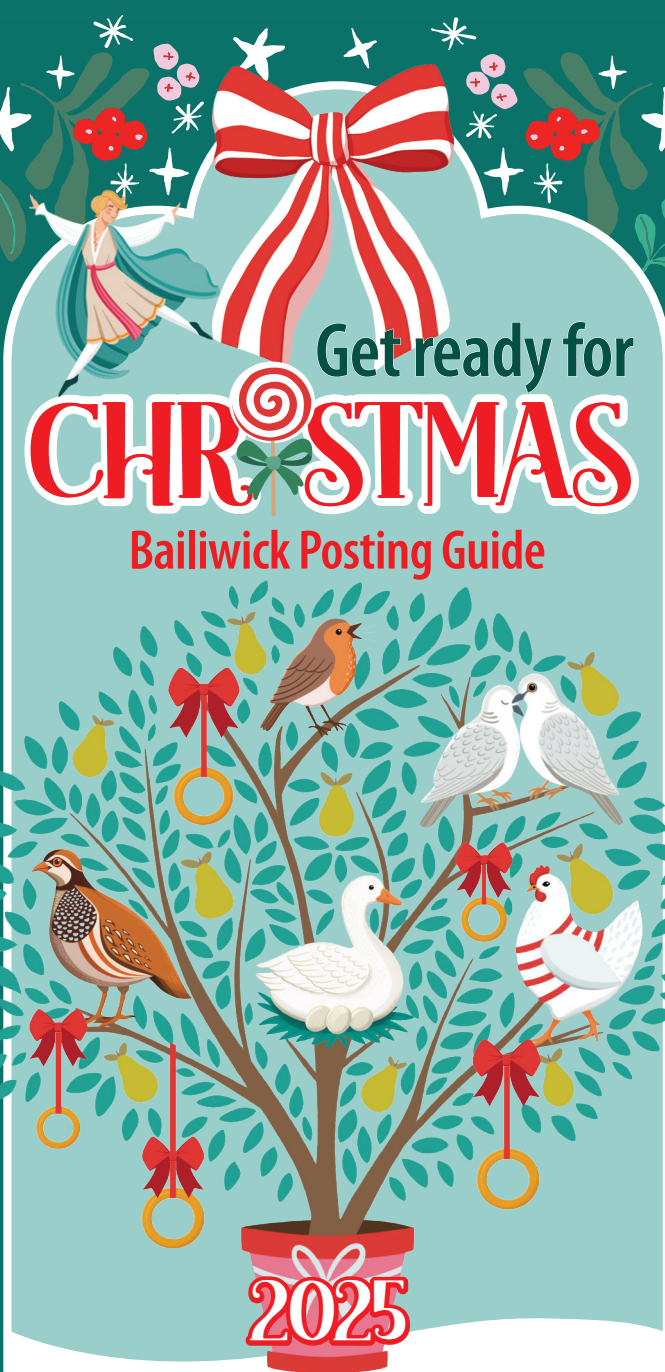
